





Explanation: Ordinarily one would not be allowed to marry the sister of the woman that he has the obligation to perform *yibum* to (*"achot zikato"*). In this case, if the first brother does *chalitzah* to the first of the sisters and she was the real wife, then the second brother can perform *"yibum"* and marry the second sister as she is no longer defined as *achot zikato* as the obligation has been fulfilled by his brother. If the first sister however was not the real wife, then when the first brother did *chalitzah* it was meaningless and the second brother then performs real *yibum*.
